

National Identity Card (Civil Identity Register) Regulations 2015

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THE NATIONAL IDENTITY CARD ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under sections 3(2)(b) and 10 of the National Identity Card Act

1. These regulations may be cited as the **National Identity Card (Civil Identity Register) Regulations 2015**.

2. In these regulations —

“Act” means the National Identity Card Act;

“entry” has the same meaning as in the Civil Status Act.

3. For the purpose of these regulations, the register shall be known as the Civil Identity Register.

4. For the purpose of section 3(2)(b) of the Act, the following information in respect of the identity of a citizen of Mauritius shall be recorded in the Civil Identity Register —

(a) the entry in the birth certificate;

(b) date of birth;

(c) marital status;

- (d) the entry in the marriage certificate, where applicable;
- (e) official document evidencing a divorce, where applicable;
- (f) residential address;
- (g) proof of residential address;
- (h) the application form referred to in regulation 3 of the National Identity Card Regulations 2013 and duly signed by the citizen;
- (i) identity card information;
- (j) transaction information;
- (k) photograph in jpeg format;
- (l) NIC number; and
- (m) signature or thumbprint where the citizen is unable to sign.

5. Any particulars in respect of the identity of a citizen of Mauritius recorded in the register under the National Identity Card (Particulars in Register) Regulations 2013 shall be deemed to have been recorded in the Civil Identity Register under these regulations.

6. The National Identity Card (Particulars in Register) Regulations 2013 are revoked.

7. These regulations shall come into operation on 14 September 2015.
